

## Highway 9 - Road Construction 2010 – Near Zion Tunnel

Scenic Highway 9 (just above and below the tunnel) within Zion National Park, will be under construction from June 7 to October 28. This is the main road that passes through the park. To accommodate visitors, officials have established a very helpful construction schedule.

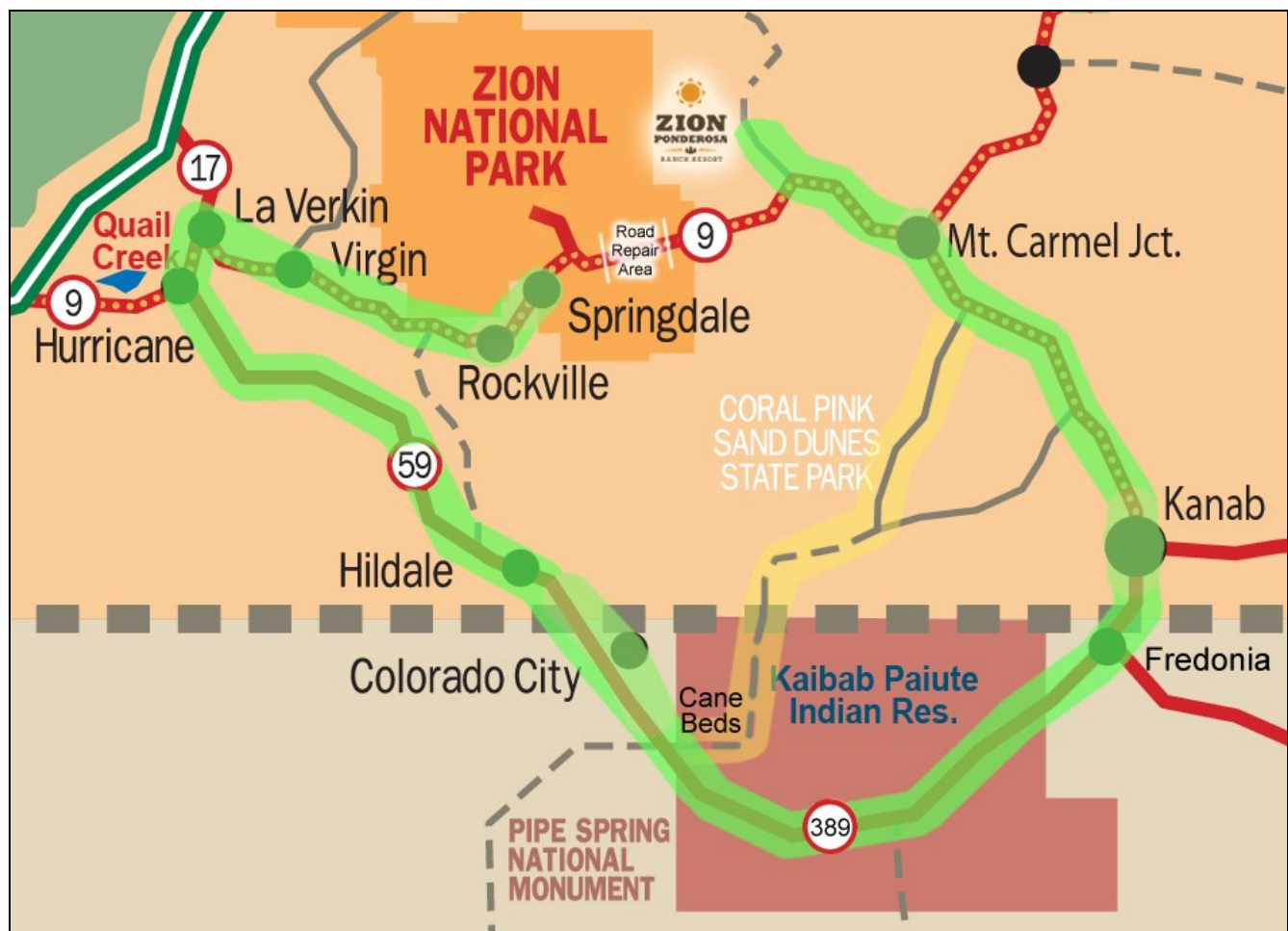
### Friday, Saturday & Holidays – No Closures – HIGHWAY 9 IS OPEN Sunday thru Thursday (Night Closures)

- Highway 9 is closed for repair from 8:00 p.m. until 8:00 a.m.
- Highway 9 is open from 8:00 a.m. To 8:00 p.m.

**Time:** Utah is in the Mountain Time Zone - one hour ahead of Nevada and Arizona.

**When road is closed:** We recommend that you use these very scenic alternate routes shown on the map below. Travel time is between 1.3 hours and 1.7 hours – depending on route.

**Guests:** If arriving or departing Zion Ponderosa (to and from Interstate 15) during construction hours, follow alternate route (shown on map below). If coming from the north / south, you will easily access Zion Ponderosa via highway 89, as normal. Guests going early to Zion National Park (on closure days) may want to be at the east gate of Zion just prior to 8:00 a.m. Guests returning to Zion Ponderosa through Zion N.P. (on closure days) should be at park entrance by 7:00 p.m. to ensure passage. Please note that the main canyon of Zion is always open. Park shuttles will run as normal.



**Green Line:** Paved highways. Includes the community of Kanab with shops, restaurants and other attractions.

**Yellow Line:** Time saving route. Dotted lines are un-paved roads. Passes Coral Pink Sand Dunes State Park. Traveling from west look for sign that says Kane Beds. Even with normal park traffic, this can be a good option.
